THE CORE READING

Poetry: A Collage of Words

THE WRITING

Cluster 7 • Module 1 • Entering the Poem

Teach BIG™ Grade 5 • Narrative and Poetry

WHAT YOUR CLASS ALREADY KNOWS

Your students have read and written poetry in Bluebonnet. They can notice imagery, sound, and the feelings a poem creates.

THE WRITING WE ADD

Cluster 7 writes narrative and poetry. Module 1 enters a poem, noticing how its lines are arranged and what feeling they carry.

TWO WAYS TO RUN IT, TEACHER'S CHOICE

USING BLUEBONNET CORE CONTENT

Have students name the feeling in a Bluebonnet poem and one way its lines are arranged.

USING THE WRITING ACADEMY SUPPLEMENTAL CONTENT

Or use our Cluster 7 poem, One Voice Can Start a Wave, to enter the poem from our content.

A FIVE MINUTE BRIDGE

Read four lines aloud. Ask students to name the feeling and one thing they notice about the lines. In five minutes they will read like poets.

THE WRITING

Cluster 7 • Module 2 • Voice and Perspective

Teach BIG™ Grade 5 • Narrative and Poetry

WHAT YOUR CLASS ALREADY KNOWS

Your students have studied Juneteenth and its history in Bluebonnet. They can explain what freedom meant and why the day still matters.

THE WRITING WE ADD

Module 2 hears the voice. Students ask who is speaking and whose perspective the words carry.

TWO WAYS TO RUN IT, TEACHER'S CHOICE

USING BLUEBONNET CORE CONTENT

Have students name the speaker and the feeling in a Bluebonnet Juneteenth poem or account.

USING THE WRITING ACADEMY SUPPLEMENTAL CONTENT

Or use our Cluster 7 poem to find the voice from our content.

A FIVE MINUTE BRIDGE

Read a short stanza. Ask students who is speaking and how that voice feels. In five minutes they will hear a poem's voice.

Teach BIG™ Grade 5 • Narrative and Poetry

WHAT YOUR CLASS ALREADY KNOWS

Your students have read and written poetry in Bluebonnet. They can notice imagery, sound, and the feelings a poem creates.

THE WRITING WE ADD

Module 3 listens closely. Students notice imagery and comparison, and they hear rhyme, rhythm, and repetition.

TWO WAYS TO RUN IT, TEACHER'S CHOICE

USING BLUEBONNET CORE CONTENT

Have students find one image in a Bluebonnet poem and one place where sound repeats.

USING THE WRITING ACADEMY SUPPLEMENTAL CONTENT

Or use our Cluster 7 poem to mark imagery and sound from our content.

A FIVE MINUTE BRIDGE

Ask students to write one line of imagery, then add a repeated sound. In five minutes they will use a poet's tools.

Cluster 7 • Module 4 • Writing a Narrative or Poem

Teach BIG™ Grade 5 • Narrative and Poetry

WHAT YOUR CLASS ALREADY KNOWS

Your students have written personal narratives in Bluebonnet. They know how to shape a true story from their own life with detail and a clear message.

THE WRITING WE ADD

Module 4 creates. Students write their own short narrative or poem, shaping a clear feeling and message.

TWO WAYS TO RUN IT, TEACHER'S CHOICE

USING BLUEBONNET CORE CONTENT

Have students write a few lines of narrative or a short stanza sparked by their Bluebonnet reading.

USING THE WRITING ACADEMY SUPPLEMENTAL CONTENT

Or use our Cluster 7 poem, Try, Learn, Change, as a model to write from our content.

A FIVE MINUTE BRIDGE

Ask students to write one four line stanza or a short moment with a clear feeling. In five minutes they will make something of their own.
