

Selecting Strong Evidence

Evidence that connects, supports, and helps you infer

WHAT WE ARE LEARNING

This week your child is learning to choose the **strongest evidence** from a text, not just any detail, but the proof that truly connects to the idea and supports the answer.

NOTICE IT TOGETHER

When your child makes a claim at home, "that team is the best," "this is the better snack," ask them to give you the best reason, not just any reason.

Cuando su hijo afirme algo en casa, pídale la mejor razón, no cualquier razón.

TALK ABOUT IT

Ask your child: "Of all your reasons, which one is the strongest, and why is it stronger than the others?"

Pregunte: de todas tus razones, ¿cuál es la más fuerte y por qué?

TRY THIS TOGETHER (NO MATERIALS NEEDED)

Play **Best Proof Wins**. Name a simple opinion, then each of you gives one piece of proof. Together, decide whose proof is strongest and say why.

Jueguen a Gana la Mejor Prueba. Digan una opinión y cada uno da una prueba; juntos decidan cuál es la más fuerte.

How to help without giving the answer. You do not need the right answer. Just keep asking why, why is that your best proof, until your child can explain what makes one piece of evidence stronger than another.
