

Reading the Prompt Closely

Prompt analysis and a clear central idea

Grade 3 • Cluster 3 • Module 1

WHAT WE ARE LEARNING

This week your child is going deeper, reading a longer prompt carefully and writing a **clear central idea** that answers all of what it asks.

NOTICE IT TOGETHER

When you give your child a longer set of directions, ask them to repeat back everything it asked for, not just the first part.

Cuando de instrucciones largas, pida a su hijo que repita todo lo que se pedia, no solo el inicio.

TALK ABOUT IT

Ask your child: "Did your answer cover everything the question asked, or just part of it?"

Pregunte: tu respuesta cubrio todo lo que pedia la pregunta, o solo una parte?

TRY THIS TOGETHER (NO MATERIALS NEEDED)

Play **Say It All Back**. Give a two-part instruction, like "grab a spoon and tell me your favorite color." Your child must do both and notice when a part is missed.

Jueguen a Repitelo Todo. De una instruccion de dos partes y su hijo debe hacer ambas.

How to help without giving the answer. Just ask, did you answer the whole thing? Help your child learn to check a prompt for every part before deciding they are done.
