

# Strong Reasons for a Why Question

Magnifying the reasons

### WHAT WE ARE LEARNING

This week your child is learning to build **strong reasons** when a prompt asks why, and to make each reason clear and convincing.

*Esta semana su hijo aprende a dar razones fuertes cuando la pregunta pide un por que.*

### NOTICE IT TOGETHER

When your child wants something, ask for their best why, then ask, can you make that reason even stronger?

*Cuando su hijo pida algo, pida su mejor por que y luego que lo haga aun mas fuerte.*

### TALK ABOUT IT

Ask your child: "**Why is that a strong reason, and how could you make it even stronger?**"

*Pregunte: por que es fuerte esa razon y como la harias aun mas fuerte?*

### TRY THIS TOGETHER (NO MATERIALS NEEDED)

Play **Make It Stronger**. One of you gives a weak reason, like "because I said so." The other turns it into a strong one with a real explanation.

*Jueguen a Hazla Mas Fuerte. Uno da una razon debil y el otro la convierte en una fuerte.*

**How to help without giving the answer.** Keep asking why until the reason really stands on its own. That gentle pushing is how strong reasoning grows.
