

Starting with a Plan

Telling the reader your purpose

Grade 3 • Cluster 4 • Module 3

WHAT WE ARE LEARNING

This week your child is learning to **open a piece of writing by telling the reader the plan**, what this writing is going to do.

Esta semana su hijo aprende a comenzar diciendo al lector el plan de su escrito.

NOTICE IT TOGETHER

Before your child tells a long story, ask them to give you a one-line heads up first, like a movie preview.

Antes de un cuento largo, pida a su hijo un adelanto de una linea.

TALK ABOUT IT

Ask your child: **"How could you tell your reader, right at the start, what your writing is about?"**

Pregunte: como le dirias al lector, desde el inicio, de que trata tu escrito?

TRY THIS TOGETHER (NO MATERIALS NEEDED)

Play **Give the Preview**. Before telling about your day, each of you says a one-sentence preview of the main thing first.

Jueguen a Da el Adelanto. Antes de contar su dia, den un adelanto de una oracion.

How to help without giving the answer. Just ask for the preview first. Helping your child name the plan up front makes all of their writing clearer.
