

Wrapping It Up

A conclusion that restates and reflects

WHAT WE ARE LEARNING

This week your child is learning to write a **conclusion** that pulls the answer together and leaves the reader with the main point.

NOTICE IT TOGETHER

After a story or a day out, ask your child to sum it up in one sentence that captures the whole thing.

Despues de un cuento o un paseo, pida un resumen de una oracion.

TALK ABOUT IT

Ask your child: "How would you wrap this up so someone remembers the main point?"

Pregunte: como lo cerrarias para que recuerden la idea principal?

TRY THIS TOGETHER (NO MATERIALS NEEDED)

Play **The Big Finish**. Tell about anything, then challenge each other to end it with one strong closing sentence.

Jueguen a El Gran Final. Cuenten algo y terminenlo con una oracion de cierre fuerte.

How to help without giving the answer. Just ask for the wrap-up sentence. Helping your child end with the main point is a skill that carries into everything they write.
