

Making a Claim

Taking a clear position

WHAT WE ARE LEARNING

This week your child is learning to write a **claim**, a clear position they can defend, for an opinion or argument prompt.

Esta semana su hijo aprende a escribir una postura clara que puede defender.

NOTICE IT TOGETHER

When your child has an opinion, ask them to state it as one bold, clear sentence.

Cuando su hijo opine, pida que lo diga en una oracion clara y firme.

TALK ABOUT IT

Ask your child: "What is your position, stated so clearly that no one could miss it?"

Pregunte: cual es tu postura, dicha tan claro que nadie la pueda perder?

TRY THIS TOGETHER (NO MATERIALS NEEDED)

Play **Take a Stand**. Name a fun debate, best pizza topping, and each of you states your claim in one confident sentence.

Jueguen a Toma Postura. Elijan un debate divertido y cada uno diga su postura en una oracion.

How to help without giving the answer. Just ask for the clear position first. A strong claim is the foundation the whole argument stands on.
