

Backing Up the Claim

Supporting a position with reasons

WHAT WE ARE LEARNING

This week your child is learning to **support a claim with strong reasons**, so an argument is convincing, not just loud.

Esta semana su hijo aprende a apoyar su postura con razones fuertes.

NOTICE IT TOGETHER

When your child wants to convince you of something, ask for two good reasons, not just one.

Cuando su hijo quiera convencerle, pida dos buenas razones.

TALK ABOUT IT

Ask your child: **"What are your two strongest reasons, and why would they convince someone?"**

Pregunte: cuales son tus dos mejores razones y por que convencerian a alguien?

TRY THIS TOGETHER (NO MATERIALS NEEDED)

Play **Convince Me**. Your child tries to convince you of a fun idea using real reasons. You only say yes when a reason truly lands.

Jueguen a Convenceme. Su hijo le convence con razones reales; usted acepta solo cuando una razon funciona.

How to help without giving the answer. Play a friendly skeptic. The more you ask why should I agree, the stronger your child's reasons become.
