

The Whole Argument

Putting a persuasive piece together

WHAT WE ARE LEARNING

This week your child is putting a **full argument together**, claim, reasons, proof, and a strong close, so it persuades from start to finish.

Esta semana su hijo une un argumento completo: postura, razones, pruebas y cierre.

NOTICE IT TOGETHER

When your family decides something together, notice the back-and-forth of claims and reasons out loud.

Cuando decidan algo en familia, noten en voz alta las posturas y razones.

TALK ABOUT IT

Ask your child: "Does your argument hold together from your claim all the way to your ending?"

Pregunte: tu argumento se sostiene desde la postura hasta el final?

TRY THIS TOGETHER (NO MATERIALS NEEDED)

Play **Make Your Case**. Your child argues for a small privilege using a claim, two reasons, and a closing line. You judge whether it holds together.

Jueguen a Presenta tu Caso. Su hijo argumenta con postura, dos razones y un cierre.

How to help without giving the answer. Just check that it flows from claim to close. Helping your child see the whole shape makes their arguments far stronger.
