

Writing a Persuasive Letter

Argument in a real letter

WHAT WE ARE LEARNING

This week your child is learning to put an argument into a **persuasive letter**, written to a real reader for a real purpose.

Esta semana su hijo aprende a escribir una carta persuasiva a un lector real.

NOTICE IT TOGETHER

Talk about a small change your child would like, then imagine together who they would write to about it.

Hablen de un cambio que su hijo quisiera y a quien le escribiría.

TALK ABOUT IT

Ask your child: "If you wrote a letter to ask for this, how would you make the reader want to say yes?"

Pregunte: si escribieras una carta para pedir esto, como harías que el lector diga sí?

TRY THIS TOGETHER (NO MATERIALS NEEDED)

Play **Dear Someone**. Out loud, your child drafts a two-sentence persuasive note to a real person, a coach, a principal, asking politely with a reason.

Jueguen a Estimado. Su hijo dice en voz alta una nota persuasiva de dos oraciones con una razón.

How to help without giving the answer. Just be the reader. Ask what would make you say yes, so your child learns to write for a real audience.
