

Stepping Into a Poem

Reading poems that make us feel

Grade 3 • Cluster 7 • Module 1

WHAT WE ARE LEARNING

This week your child is learning to **enter a poem**, to read slowly and notice the feeling it creates.

Esta semana su hijo aprende a entrar en un poema y notar el sentimiento que crea.

NOTICE IT TOGETHER

Read a short poem or song lyric together and ask your child how it made them feel, and which words did it.

Lean un poema corto juntos y pregunte que sintio y que palabras lo lograron.

TALK ABOUT IT

Ask your child: **"What feeling did that poem give you, and which words created it?"**

Pregunte: que sentimiento te dio el poema y que palabras lo crearon?

TRY THIS TOGETHER (NO MATERIALS NEEDED)

Play **Feeling Words**. Read a few lines aloud, then each of you names the feeling in one word and points to the line that made it.

Jueguen a Palabras de Sentimiento. Lean unas lineas y nombren el sentimiento y la linea que lo causo.

How to help without giving the answer. There is no wrong feeling. Just ask which words did it, so your child learns to connect language to emotion.
