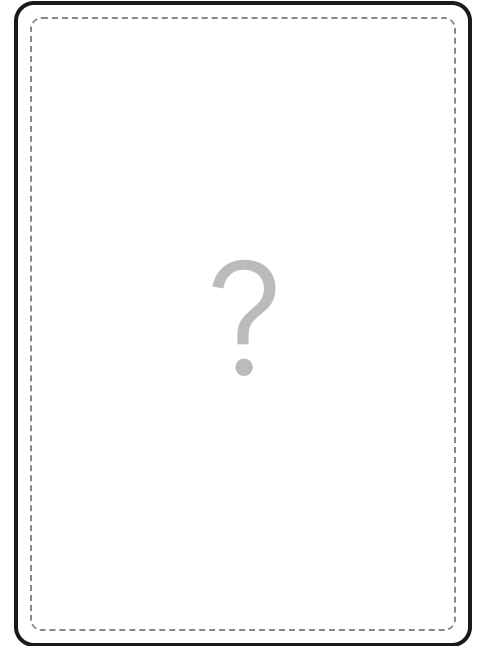
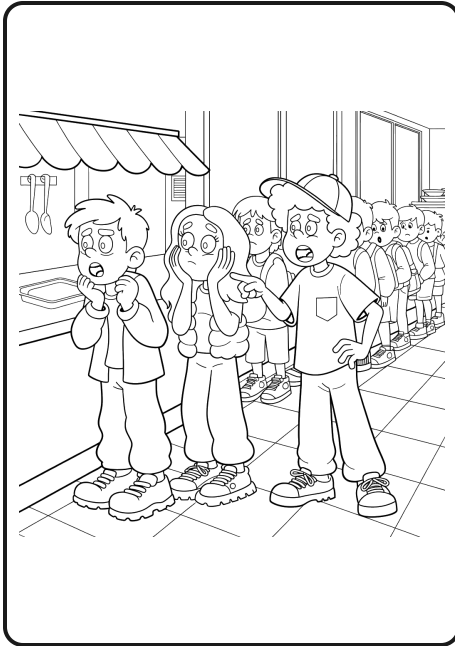

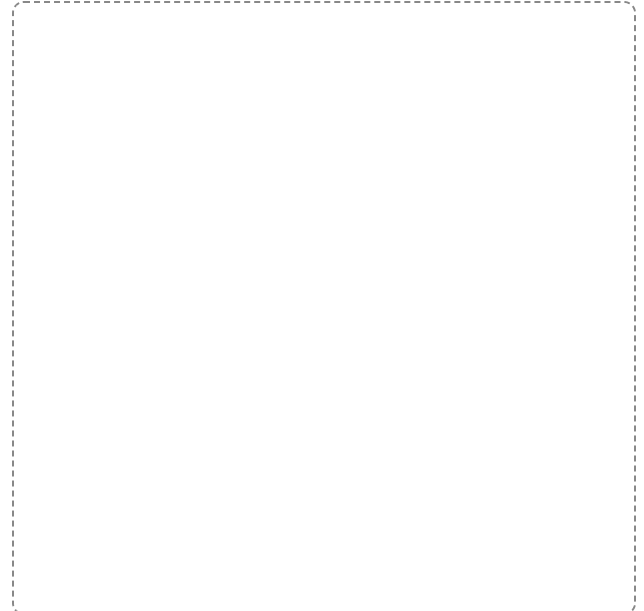

3. Color both panels.

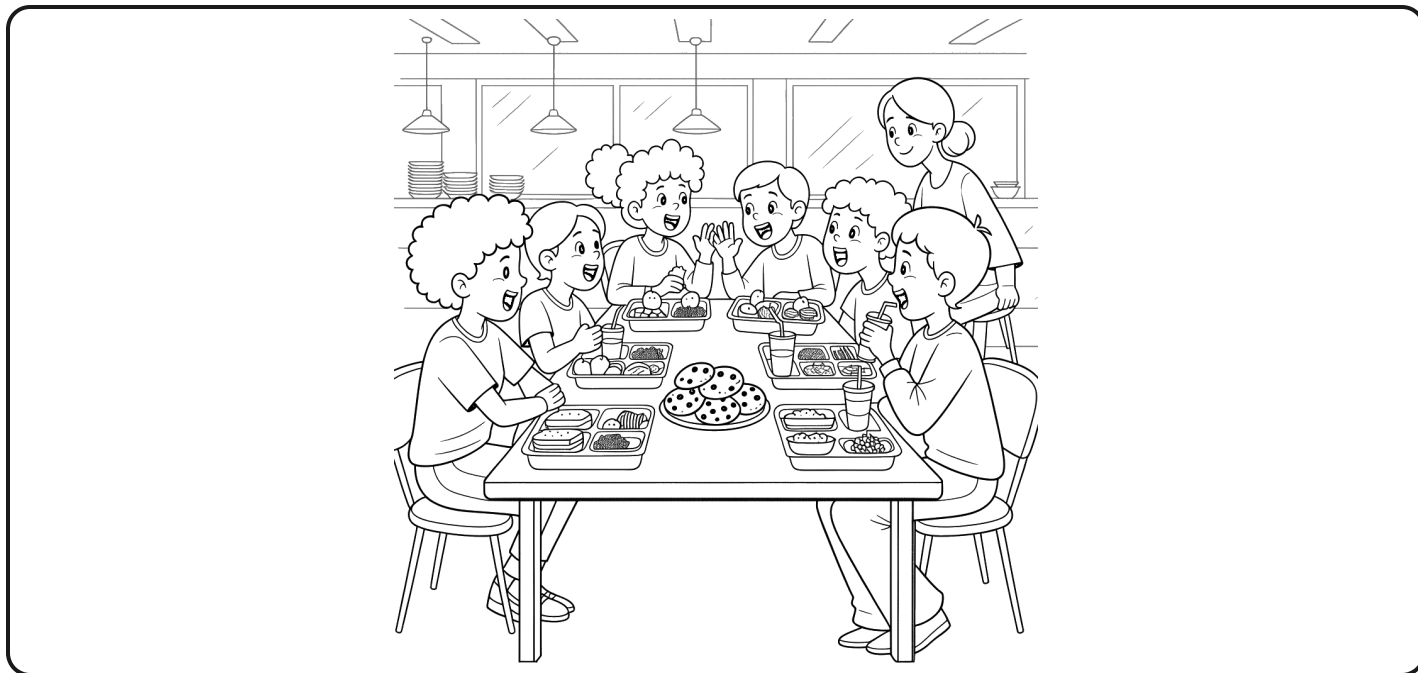

2. Fix it: cross out the unsupported detail and draw what the passage really describes in its place. Then color the corrected picture.

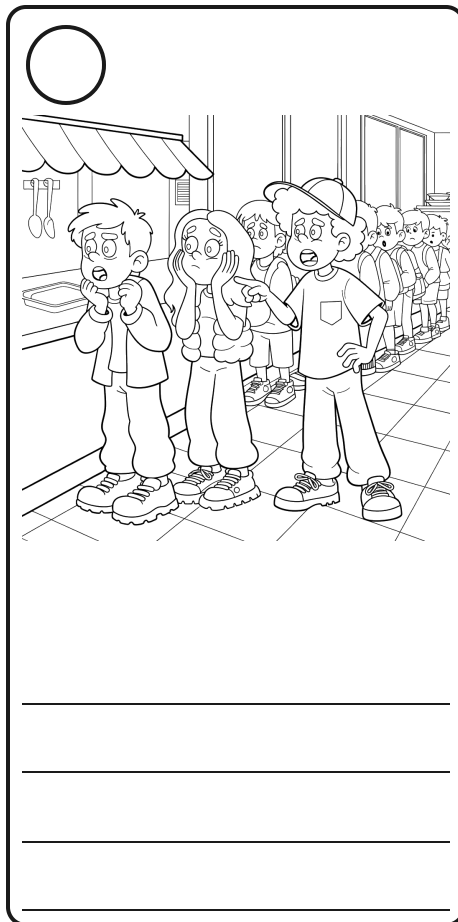
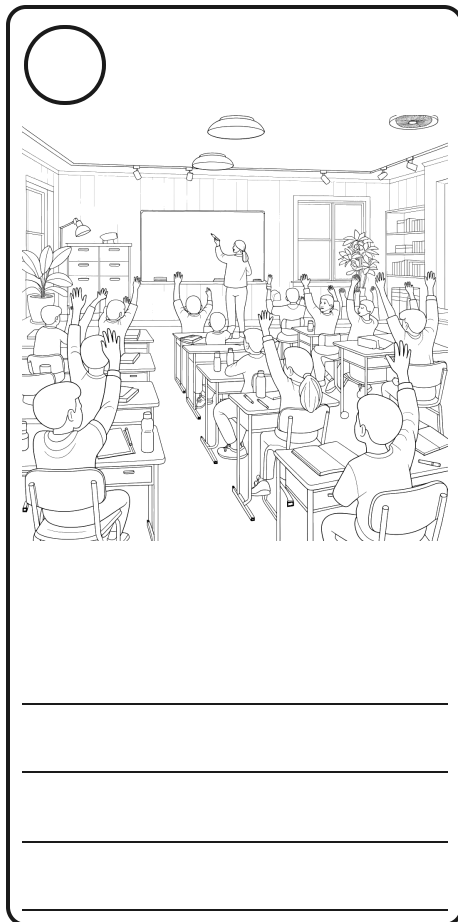
