Big Word Detective • Prefixes of place and direction.



INTRO

Detective's back on the beat — which WAY did that word go?
Follow the prefix up front, and the direction will show!

CHORUS

I'm the Big Word Detective — case cracked!
Break it apart, take a big word back!
The part up front tells you WHERE to go —
under, over, across — now you know!

VERSE 1

SUB means UNDER — a submarine dives down below!
SUPER means ABOVE — a superhero steals the show!
INTER means BETWEEN — the internet links me to you!
TRANS means ACROSS — transportation carries us through!

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VERSE 2

CIRCUM means AROUND — I circumnavigate the sea!
MID means the MIDDLE — it's midday, come count with me!
EX means OUT — the exit's the way to go!
PRE means BEFORE — the preview starts the show!
POST means AFTER — the postgame's the last we'll know!

BRIDGE

Sub under, super above, inter between!
Trans across, circum around — you're a word-cracking machine!
Ex is out, mid is middle, pre before, post after —
find the front, find the way, and fill the room with laughter!
